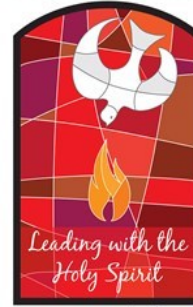


# GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENTS

**REGISTRATION DEADLINE: June 17th**

Camp Cadiz gives students the opportunity to share the love of Jesus through local mission projects. The event will take place July 8-12th. It will feature mission projects in Cadiz & Trigg County, nightly Worship Services, fun & fellowship.

**MISSION OPPORTUNITY:** All projects are located in Cadiz & Trigg County. Participants will be divided into work groups with an assigned Project Leader and Adult Leader. Work groups (not church groups) travel to job sites and worship services together. Work groups will complete a variety of mission projects and share the love of Jesus with everyone they encounter that week. Work groups change each year based on need in the community. Some previous work groups have been: Pressure washing, construction, chores for the elderly, yard work, painting, RAK (Random Acts of Kindness), VBS, Feeding Friends, Nursing Home Ministry, etc.

**SCHEDULE:** A typical day consists of Opening Devotion, work at job sites, lunch provided by local church, more work at job sites, showers, supper provided by local church, Evening Worship.

**HOW CAN YOU HELP?** Pray. Pray for the participants, pray for the camp pastors and music leader, pray for the team organizing the event, pray for the individuals that see the work of Camp Cadiz Missionaries and experience God's love, and last but not least pray for those considering stepping up to become an adult leader.
