WHAT CAN YOUR DOLLAR DO?

The Way on Lafayette Street provides recreational shelter for many students. We provide a safe environment for the kids so that they can have a place to spend time with their peers, play games, play basketball, skateboard, ride scooters, learn how to cook, quilt, sew, play the guitar, play a keyboard, participate in various craft activities, etc. We also have a daily devotion normally led by one of the local pastors.

If you don't already know, this service is 100% voluntary. We feed the kids and supervise all their activities. We are normally open from 3 to 6 p.m. Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, and 3 to 9 p.m. on Friday.

Now here is what your dollar can do. We provide bottled water and powdered drink mixes for the kids. We have several flavors and go through literally hundreds of bottles of water and tubes of powdered drink mix a week. For \$1, you can provide eight kids with a flavored drink mix. For \$2, you can provide 24 bottles of that water.

Won't you please consider giving \$1, \$2, or even \$3 to these kids? The board members and volunteers of The Way thank you for your support. Drop by and see us sometime.

There will be a basket for donations outside the sanctuary for anyone who cares to donate.
